

Cornerstones for secondary use in Finland

- Rich national data registers
 - in practice 100% coverage of Finnish population
- Opt-out principle in secondary use of social and health data => consent not required for registry based research
- Personal identity code: a key to linking personal information from various registers
- Data security and data safety => trust

Legal basis: Act on Secondary Use of Health and Social Data

To streamline and secure the secondary use of social and health data

Findata:

- Prescribes the establishment, tasks, services, steering and supervision of Findata
- Gives Findata authority to grant permissions for secondary use of Finnish health and social data
- Status: Findata is an independent authority located in the Finnish Institute for Health and Welfare

Legal basis: Act on Secondary Use of Health and Social Data

- According to the Act, data can be granted to following secondary use purposes:
 - Scientific research
 - Statistics
 - Development and innovations
 - Teaching
 - Knowledge based management
 - Authorities' steering, supervision, planning and reporting duties

- Anonymization services




To streamline and secure the secondary use of health and social care data



FINDATA First year milestones - Up and running!



Two types of data

Individual level data

- Available in a remote access environment for a set period
- Direct identifying data removed
- For the purposes specified in the Act

Statistical level data

- Delivered to the customer
- Free use for the purposes specified in the Act

→ A data utilisation plan is always required to access data sets

Findata:

- Requests client for additional information (if needed)
- Contacts data controllers → Define sampling
 - → Cost estimate (applicant's approval)

Client: order remote access environment

Controllers: data sampling and transfer to Findata

Findata: data management

Findata:

- Provides tools for analysis
- Controls anonymity of results
- Removes the data after the permit expires

Findata issues R&D&I infrastructure regulations

Regulation on the requirements of secure operating environments (October 2020)

- Regulation concerns the secondary use of social and health data
- Analysis of data at individual level is permitted only in environments that meet the requirements of the regulation


Regulation on data description contents, concepts and datastructures (Feb 2021)



Pricing of services

- Based on
 - Act on Secondary Use of Health and Social Data (50§)
 - Decree issued by Ministry of Social Affairs and Health
- Prices consist of four elements:
 - Findata permit fee
 - Findata data management work
 - Reimburses for data controllers' sample costs
 - Payment for remote access

REMOTE ACCESS ENVIRONMENT PACKAGES

- S (small):
 - 8 GB RAM
 - 4 cores
- M (medium):
 - 16 GB RAM
 - 6 cores
- L (large):
 - 32 GB RAM
 - 8 cores
- XL (MaxPower):
 - 90 GB RAM
 - 20 cores

- Compliance with the Act supervised by
 - Ministry of Social Affairs and Health
 - Data Protection Ombudsman
 - National Supervisory Authority for Welfare and Health (Valvira)

- Data sets made available without individual's direct identifiers
- A secure remote access environment for individual level data sets
- Security in Findata operating environment will be controlled by an information security inspection body and Valvira
